The contract for Abatement Bid Package #09 is awarded to Environmental Demolition Group in the amount of \$44,000.00, as the lowest responsible bidder for the specified work, based upon the information provided to the Board for its review, including the Construction Manager's letter of recommendation for award, prepared in consultation with the Architect. Each contract awarded by the Board is subject to the approval of the Ohio School Facilities Commission and does not create a property right until signed by all parties.
- 2. The Superintendent, Treasurer, and Board President are authorized to execute a contract and any required related documentation with Environmental Demolition Group in the amount of \$44,000.00 for the demolition required for the Primary and Intermediate Buildings.
