

WHAT DO YOUR CONFERENCES LOOK LIKE?

WHY DO STUDENT LED CONFERENCES?

- show parents and students that their opinions and experiences are valued by the teacher
- empower the child to take responsibility for his/her learning
- give the parent and teacher a chance to hear the student reflect on his progress in his own words
- hold students accountable for their academic and behavioral choices
- take unnecessary pressure off of the teacher by focusing on the student and his/her work samples

HOW TO GET STARTED?

- Start a student work sample portfolio at the beginning of the year
- START

- Select a conference form that you want students to use during conferences
- Develop a routine where you pass back both strong and weak work samples for students to place in their work portfolios
- Inform both students and parents at the beginning of the year that you will be using student led conferences

WHEN DO STUDENTS PREPARE?

This will look different for each grade level/ teacher

Possible times for preparing students:

- Connect time grades 6-12
- Center/Station time
- At home (For older students)
